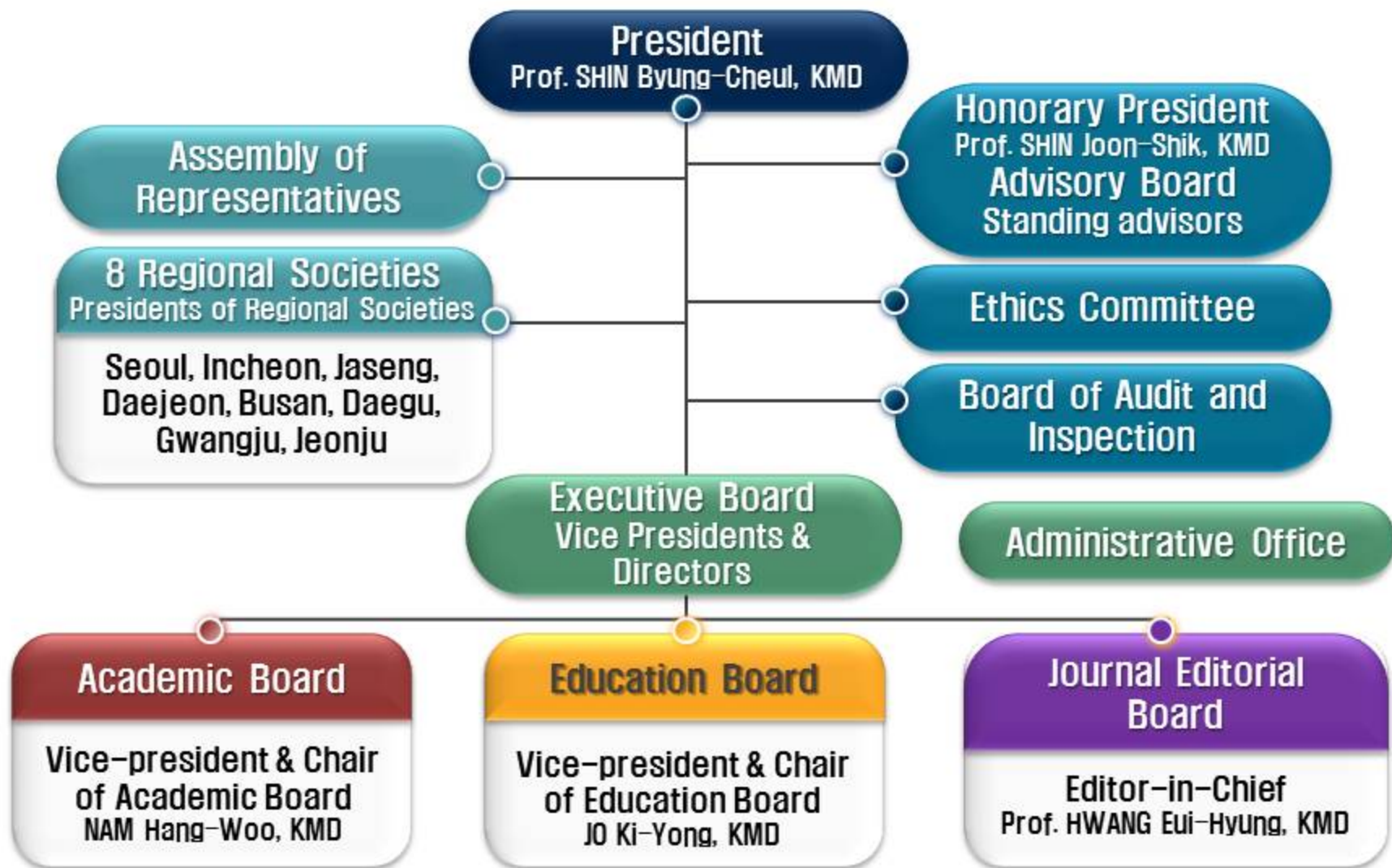

# Organizational chart of KSCMM Steering Committee





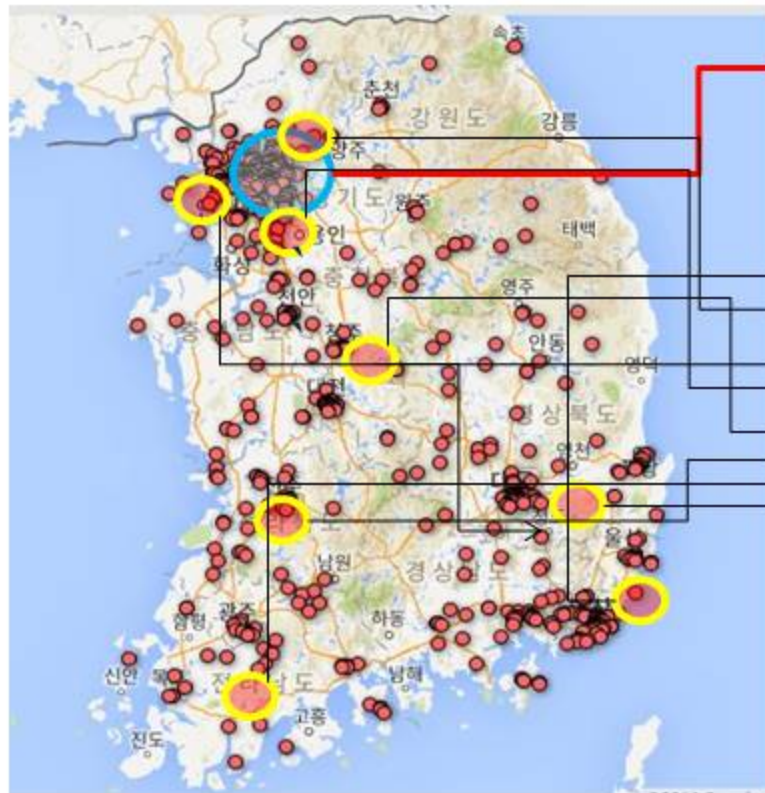

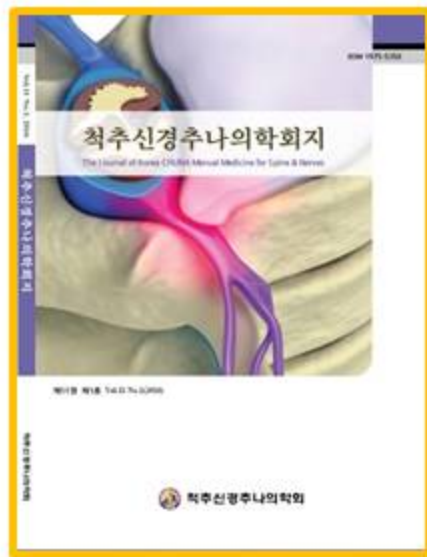

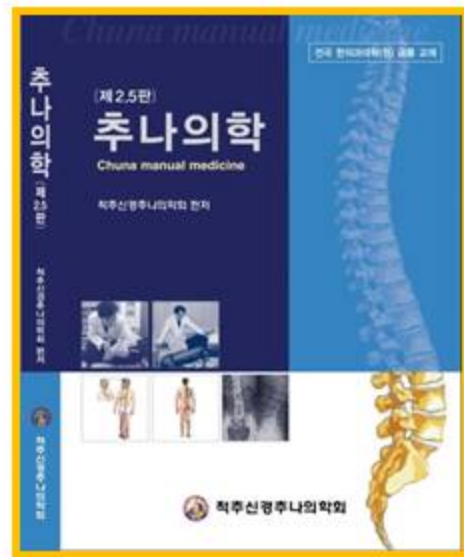
